Dr Lan Luh Luh holds a joint position as an Associate Professor of Law at the NUS Business School and Faculty of Law, National University of Singapore. Until recently, she was the Deputy Chairman of the Centre for Law & Business (CLB) (previously known as the Centre for Commercial Law Studies) at the Faculty of Law (2011-2015). She currently serves as a Board member of CLB. She is also a Board member of the Executive Education at the NUS Business School. She has a PhD in Business Policy, and LLB from NUS and a LLM (First Class) from the University of Cambridge.

Prof Lan lectures and researches in corporate finance law, company law and corporate governance. Her works have been published in academic journals like the *Academy of Management Review*, *Harvard Business Review* and *Law Quarterly Review*. In addition, she is the co-author of the book, "The 36 Strategies of the Chinese", one of the nine books highly recommended by Malaysia's Royal Professor Ungku Abdul Aziz. She also contributed various chapters to a number of authoritative law books such as *Walter Woon on Company Law*, ed. CH Tan and *Law relating to Specific Contracts in Singapore*, ed. TM Yeo and M Hwang.

She is actively involved in the various regulatory reform activities relating to company law and corporate governance in Singapore and internationally. She currently sits on the Charity Council Board which advises the Singapore Commissioner of Charities and is also the Singapore representative of the EU-Asia Corporate Governance Dialogue of the European Corporate Governance Institute.
